

Manual Handling Train the Trainer

Description:

The course covers manual handling as well as training techniques and lesson planning for delivering a course. It provides specialist information to enable individuals to deliver in-house manual handling training to their colleagues. This course is in accordance with the Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992 and is designed to help trainers introduce delegates to the hazards and risks associated with manual handling. The course will enable trainers to help employees develop safer manual handling techniques. This course details training techniques and emphasises how delegates can get the most out of their training course.

- Understand different learning styles
- Work in a team to complete a practical task
- Get the most out of communication techniques
- Get the most out of different learning resources
- Write an effective lesson plan
- Be able to manage a practical activity
- Be competent to deliver manual handling training in-house
