

Noise Awareness - Noise Protection

Description:

This course prepares employees to contribute to the safer use of hazardous substances in their workplace. The course introduces delegates to substances that may be hazardous in the workplace, details the risks and controls available and outlines what to expect from a Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) assessment.

Objectives:

On completion of the course, delegates will have covered the following areas:

- Introduction to COSHH
- The scope of hazardous substances in the workplace
- The range of legislation covering hazardous substances
- How hazardous substances adversely affect health
- Methods of identifying hazardous substances
- Sources of guidance available for the safe use of hazardous substances
- The range of control measures available for the safe use of hazardous substances
- The purpose and content of COSHH assessments
- Health problems
- COSHH assessment

Qualification:

On successful completion of the post-course assessment, delegates will receive a certificate. They can use this certificate to demonstrate the level of health and safety knowledge they have achieved.

Typical Interest Groups:

Building contractors, renovators, fit out companies, road contractors, carpenters/joiners, manufacturing industry operatives and employers, machine operators, plant operators etc. Anyone working in noisy environments.

Suitability:

This course will benefit anyone working with hazardous substances in a workplace. The programme focuses on the information that employees need to know about substance hazards and how to control them.
