

Tower Scaffold

Description:

Literacy and English language skills are important for users of mobile access towers, as delegates will need to consult, understand and fully comprehend safety instructions and the manufacturer's instruction manual. Delegates will be expected to work at height during the erection of a mobile access tower, so it's imperative that they are in good health and have no fear of heights, as these factors may prevent them from carrying out a practical assessment. Delegates must have appropriate PPE - footwear and hard hats are compulsory. Teaching and assessment: Classroom-based tutorials Practical application of knowledge through a tutor-led tower scaffolding project The assessment is a paired tower scaffolding erection carried out correctly and to relevant standards.

Objectives:

Delegates will gain an understanding of the current relevant legislation and be able to dismantle, assemble, inspect and most importantly use mobile access towers safely in accordance with current approved methods and manufacturer's instructions. At the end of the theory session, delegates will then move on to the practical assessment where they will be required to construct a mobile access tower using the 3T method.
